

preg_match_all()

- The **preg_match_all** function in PHP is used to perform a global regular expression match on a string and find all occurrences of the pattern. It returns the number of full pattern matches found (which may be zero), and the matches are stored in the specified array.

Syntax

```
preg_match_all(pattern , string , array)
```

```
/pattern/modifiers;
```
